

Prema podacima dostavljenim Zavodu za javno zdravstvo FBiH u Federaciji BiH, zaključno s 01.11.2021. u 12h, registrirano je 162 897 laboratorijski potvrđena slučaja COVID-19 bolesti i 6450 smrtnih slučajeva povezanih s COVID-19. Trenutno je evidentirano 6577 aktivnih slučajeva COVID-19.

*According to the data submitted to the Institute of Public Health of the FBiH in the Federation of BiH, as of November 1, 2021. at 12 a.m., 162,897 laboratory-confirmed case of COVID-19 and 6,450 deaths related to COVID-19 were registered. Currently registered 6,577 active cases of COVID-19.*



Na nivou Federacije BiH, 7-dnevna incidenca iznosi 138,4 slučaja/100.000 stanovnika. U posljednjih sedam dana, najviša 7-dnevna incidenca je zabilježena u Kantonu Sarajevo, Tuzlanskom Kantonu i Hercegovačko-neretvanskom kantonu.

*In the Federation of Bosnia and Herzegovina, 7-day incidence is 138,4 case/100,000 population. In the last seven days, the highest 7-day incidence was recorded in Sarajevo Canton, Tuzla Canton and Herzegovina-Neretva Canton.*


## Smrtni slučajevi

### Deaths

Do 01.11.2021 u 12h Zavodu za javno zdravstvo FBiH prijavljeno je 6450 smrtnih slučajeva povezanih s COVID-19. Prema dobnoj strukturi, osobe starije od 60 godina čine 86,3%, a prema spolnoj strukturi, muški spol je zastupljen sa 60,2%.


As of November 1, 2021, 12 a.m., 6,450 deaths related to COVID-19 were reported to the Public Health Institute of FBiH. According to the age distribution, 86,3% of deaths occurred among people over 60 years of age; according to gender, are male 60,2%.

## Hospitalizirani

### Hospitalizations

U Federaciji BiH na bolničkom liječenju trenutno je 518 osoba zbog COVID-19 bolesti, od kojih je 54 (10,4%) na invazivnoj mehaničkoj ventilaciji. Prema dostavljenim podacima, od ukupnog broja hospitaliziranih, 518 (86,7%) je necijepljenih i nepotpuno cijepljenih, a 69 (13,3%) potpuno cijepljenih.

*In FB&H, there are currently 518 people in hospital from COVID-19 disease, 54 (10,4%) of whom are in invasive mechanical ventilation. According to the submitted data, out of the total number of hospitalized, 518 (86,7%) were unvaccinated and incompletely vaccinated, and 69 (13,3%) were fully vaccinated.*

## Tjedni indikatori

### Weekly indicators

U 43. tjednu bilježi se rast svih tjednih indikatora. Najveći rast bilježi broj pacijenata COVID-19 na respiratoru, broj novih potvrđenih slučajeva COVID-19 i 7-dnevna incidenca.

*In the 43rd week, all weekly indicators increased. The largest increase was registered in number of COVID-19 patients on the respirator, number of new confirmed COVID-19 cases and 7-day incidence.*
