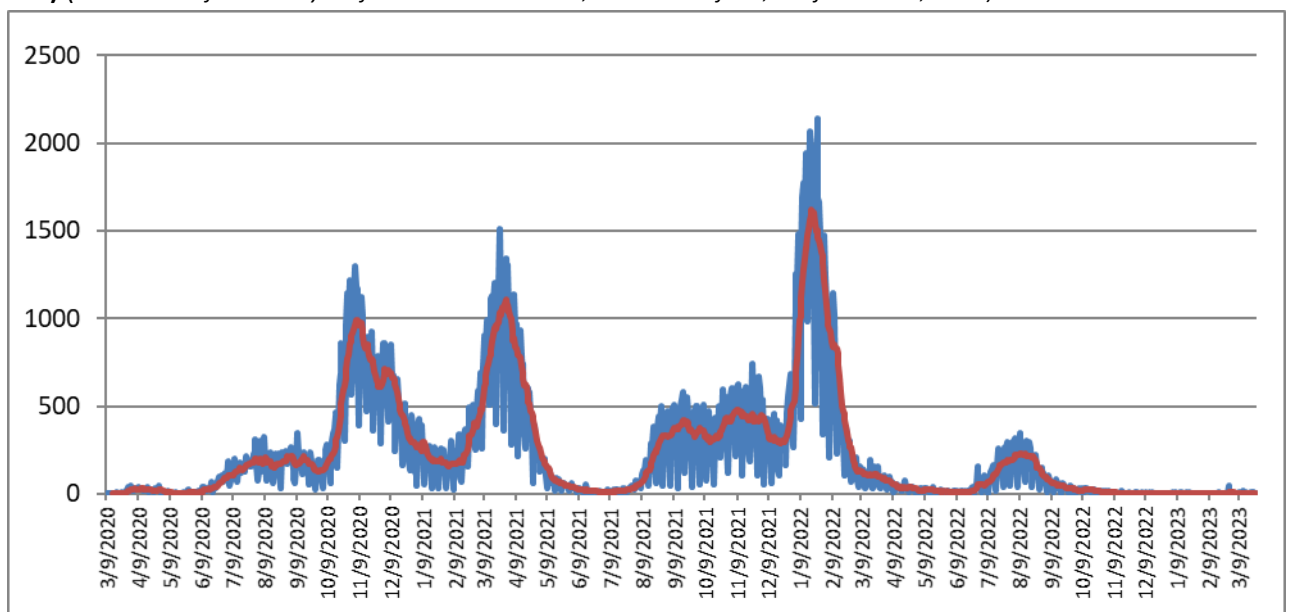

Prema podacima dostavljenim Zavodu za javno zdravstvo FBiH u Federaciji BiH, zaključno s 27.03.2023. u 12h, registrirano je 264 753 laboratorijski potvrđena slučaja COVID-19 bolesti i 9 107 smrtnih slučajeva povezanih s COVID-19.

*According to the data submitted to the Institute of Public Health of the FBiH in the Federation of BiH, as of March 27, 2023. at 12 a.m., 264,753 laboratory-confirmed cases of COVID-19 and 9,107 deaths related to COVID-19 were registered.*

Na nivou Federacije BiH, 7-dnevna incidenca iznosi 1,8 slučajeva/100.000 stanovnika. U posljednjih sedam dana, višu incidencu od prosječne zabilježene u Federaciji BiH imaju Hercegovačko-neretvanski, Posavski Kanton, Zeničko-dobojski kanton, Kanton 10, Zapadnohercegovački kanton i Srednjobosanski kanton. Rezultati antigenskih testiranja nisu uključeni u ovaj izvještaj, te stoga ne prikazuje realno stanje epidemiološke situacije. S obzirom na lakšu dostupnost, brže rezultate testa i nižu cijenu testiranja, većina zdravstvenih ustanova se odlučuje na testiranje RAT (brzi antigeni test), iako ZZJZFBiH u svojim

preporukama navodi da je u situaciji niske cirkulacije virusa SARS-CoV-2 u zajednici pouzdanost RAT značajno smanjena i preporuča se testiranje PCRom.

U proteklih 7 dana zabilježena su tri smrtna slučaja.

*In the Federation of Bosnia and Herzegovina, 7-day incidence is 1,8 cases/100,000 population. In the last seven days Herzegovina-Neretva Canton, Posavina Canton, Zenica-Doboj Canton, Canton 10, West Herzegovina Canton and Central Bosnian Canton, have a higher incidence than average recorded in the Federation of BiH. The results of antigen testing are not included in this report, and therefore do not show the real state of the epidemiological situation. Given the easier availability, faster test results and lower cost of testing, most health care institutions opt for RAT (rapid antigen test), although ZZJZFBiH states in its recommendations that in a situation of low circulation of SARS-CoV-2 virus in the community the reliability of RAT significantly reduced and PCR testing is recommended.*

U Federaciji BiH, na bolničkom liječenju\* trenutno je 28 osoba zbog COVID-19, nitko nije na invazivnoj mehaničkoj ventilaciji.
